

Sale of *ḥametz*

There are four ways we fulfil the Biblical *mitzvah* of ridding ourselves of *ḥametz* before Pesah:

- ♦ we clean our homes;
- ♦ we burn any remaining crumbs;
- ♦ we verbally declare that any *ḥametz* in our possession is worthless and no longer owned by us; and
- ♦ to ensure that there is no question about our intent to remove *ḥametz* from our possession, we sell our *ḥametz* to non-Jews who may own leavened products on Passover.
