Sale of *hametz*

There are four ways we fulfil the Biblical *mitzvah* of ridding ourselves of *ḥametz* before Pesah:

- we clean our homes;
- we burn any remaining crumbs;
- we verbally declare that any <u>hametz</u> in our possession is worthless and no longer owned by us; and
- to ensure that there is no question about our intent to remove <u>hametz</u> from our possession, we sell our <u>hametz</u> to non-Jews who may own leavened products on Passover.
