

# Sale of *Ḥametz*



## There are four ways we fulfil the Biblical mitzvah of ridding ourselves of ḥametz before Pesah

- we clean our homes;
- we burn any remaining crumbs;
- we verbally declare that any ḥametz in our possession is worthless and no longer owned by us; and
- to ensure that there is no question about our intent to remove ḥametz from our possession, we sell our ḥametz to non-Jews who may own leavened products on Passover.

If you are unable to personally sell your ḥametz, please email, fax or send this form to the Synagogue office no later than **6:00 PM on Tuesday, April 4, 2023.**
