

Sale of *Chametz*



There are four ways we fulfil the Biblical mitzvah of ridding ourselves of *chametz* before Passover:

- We clean our homes;
- We burn any remaining crumbs;
- We verbally declare that any *chametz* in our possession is worthless and longer owned by us; and
- We ensure that there is no question about our intent to remove *chametz* from our possession, we sell our *chametz* to non-Jews who may own leavened products on Passover.
