Thursday, August 7, 2025: Bruchim Habaim!

- 9 am morning arrival Welcome to Israel! ברוכים הבאים
- Meet your **Ramah Staff** at Ben Gurion Airport and then head to Jerusalem for pick up at the Dan Panorama
- Intros and orientation at the beautiful **Tayelet- Haas Promenade** lookout over Jerusalem
- Volunteer at Pantry Packers packing dry goods that will be distributed to needy Israeli families
- Lunch on own
- Daven mincha at **Azarat Yisrael** the egalitarian section of the Kotel in the **Old City** and then enjoy a walking tour with guide
- Check into the hotel
- Dinner on own at local restaurants
- Evening panel of women who are miluim wives and here about family life throughout the war

- Visit the mikvah on Kibbutz Hanaton and meet with a member of the kibbutz
- Meet with the Arab and Jewish women who work together at Sidyanna Bagalil and enjoy their spice making workshop
- Enjoy some free time and dinner on own in the beautiful lakeside town of **Tiveria**
- Check into the hotel

Monday, August 11, 2025: Golan: The Eyes of the Country

- Breakfast at hotel
- **Volunteer in a Northern community** helping to rebuild what was broken during the war (location TBD based on need)
- Lunch on own
- Go up **Mt Ben Tal** to lookout over Syria and learn about the war in the North and the borders of Israel
- Enjoy a delicious chocolate workshop at the **De Karina chocolate factory** and meet with its founder Karina, and hear about her aliyah from Argentina and how she built up her business in the Golan
- Dinner at hotel
- Evening Speaker: **Sheila Weinberg**, the first Trans women to sit on a City council (Kiryat Tivon) and learn about her political career as well as what life has been like in the North since 10/7

Tuesday, August 12, 2025: Around the Kinneret

- Breakfast at hotel and check out
- Visit the **Kinneret cemetery** and learn about some of the leading poets of Israel who are buried there including Naomi Shemer and Rachel the Poetess
- Cool off in the leisurely water hike at the refreshing **Majrase stream**
- Walk around the Mystical city of **Tsfat** starting with lunch on own. Learn about this spiritual center of Judaism, with free time for shopping.
- Meet with a local female doctor at the **Ziv hospital** and learn about the medical school and how
 the country is working to improve medical care in the periphery of the country
- Travel to Haifa
- Check in and dinner at hotel
- Evening Speaker: **Anat Hoffman**, the director and founding member of Women of the Wall

Wednesday, August 13, 2025: Coexistence

- Meet with Rabbi Natalie Lastreger at Kfar Vradim
- Enjoy lunch at the Druze village of Horfesh and learn about the Druze religion and community
- Visit the boutique **Tulip winery**, located at **Kfar Tikvah** and enjoy tastings of their unique wine while learning about this village for people with special needs
- Tour around Haifa visiting sites connected to the various religions of the city including the Stella
 Maris monastery, the Bahai Gardens and the Ahmadiyya Mosque
- Free night out with dinner on own

Thursday, August 14, 2025: TLV: The First Hebrew City

- Breakfast at hotel and check out
- Visit the **Israel Para Sports Center,** meet one of Israel's Elite Para athletes and here her story. End the visit with a game of wheelchair basketball

- Tour **Save a Child's Heart** and hear about this incredible project giving medical care to children from around the third world
